TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This competition is open to all registered IAFA members, who are undertaking research toward a Masters or Doctoral qualification. A prize fund of up to €5,000 is available in 2010.

Entry Criteria

- Applicants must submit a fully completed application form, by no later than 26th February 2010.
- Applicants must be available and present at the IAFA Annual Doctoral Colloquium event (If more individuals apply than can be facilitated to present on the day, a sub-committee of Council will draft a short-list of applicants).
- The proposed research must contribute to the aims of the IAFA.
- The successful applicant must present their research findings at the following year's IAFA Doctoral Colloquium.
- The decision of the judges is final.

The successful applicant will be presented with their prize during the Annual Conference dinner. 50% of the prize fund awarded will be made available immediately, with the remainder payable upon receipts and a report of how the monies were spent (to be sent to the Treasurer). This report must be signed by the researcher supervisor or Head of Department of the winning applicant.
