Christopher Humphrey is a Professor of Accounting and Head of the Manchester Accounting & Finance Group (MAFG), a division of Manchester Business School (MBS), University of Manchester, England.

Christopher's primary research interests are the role and regulation of the Auditing profession. Recent examples of his work in this area can be found in academic journals such as Accounting Organizations and Society and Accounting, Auditing and Accountability Journal and practitioner journals such as the FS Focus magazine published by the Financial Services Faculty of the ICAEW. He is an Associate Editor of the European Accounting Review and is also on the editorial boards of a wide range of international accounting journals. He is currently a visiting professor at Amsterdam Business School and is in the process of writing a book to be published by Oxford University Press on the history of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC). Christopher is a qualified chartered accountant. He is currently a co-opted academic member of the governing Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW) and also sits on the ICAEW's Technical Strategy Committee.
